Footnotes

MOMENT OF SONG showed good speed out from the rail to make all the pace, kicked well clear in upper stretch then held safe late under steady urging. KEMO SABE BEN stalked the pace from along the inside and continued with a mild late run to be slowly reeling in the winner. DANCE PROUDLY saved ground through the turn, angled out upper stretch and made a mild late gain but could not reach the top pair. EVERYTHING WILD was void of early speed while saving ground, swung five wide into the lane and closed but was too late. DA TRAVELIN MAN tracked the pace racing three to four wide and weakened. CALLER BLOCKED lacked a closing response from three wide. NIGHT WING failed to threaten racing two and three wide. HEZA FIRECRACKER was always back racing outside. DOCALOT was close up to the pace while three wide through the turn and gave way.
