FIREY NEW LOVE led in the early going between rivals, angled in through the turn, gained a clear lead into the stretch, then was kept to the task. THREE ELEVENS well back and four wide, gained a striking position through the turn, fanned five wide to bid into the stretch, then close well to get up for the place. COPY RUNNER vied for the early lead outside, dropped back into the turn, steadied off a rivals heels, bid four wide into the stretch to have a steady gain and miss the place but held the show safe. TALLBOYS TAVERN tracked the pace on the rail, got through inside of rivals at the quarter pole, drifted out through the stretch run and could not gain in the late going. HUM THAT TUNE passed tiring rivals. PRINCE DON stalked the pace four wide, steadied off heels into the turn, faded in the drive. FAMOUS FROLIC close up and three wide, angled in into the turn, came to the winner at the quarter pole, then had no rally. ENHANCED EDITION was never involved. TUNNEL MARTE vied for the early lead on the rail, stopped.
