Footnotes

BRASS BOLT stalked the pace outside, bid three wide into the stretch, drifted in in the lane and drew off in upper stretch under steady handling. STALWART TEE well back and four wide in the early going, gained a striking position through the turn, bid five wide into the stretch to get up for the place late while no threat to the winner. SEAPOPS close up and four wide, bid on that path into the stretch, close fast in mid stretch to be best of the rest while no threat to the top two. SOLON EXPRESS set the early pace on the rail, gained a clear lead through the turn, kept position into the stretch and weakened in the drive. LAIRD never far back, bid three wide into the stretch, then had no rally. PEAKINGTOM improved position. TEE'S BEST MAN was not a factor. COME SWAY WITH ME tracked the pace on the rail, kept position through the stretch, then weakened in upper stretch. INDIANA GOLD was never involved. DR. BUFFINGTON showed little.
