STAKES Indiana Futurity Black Type - Thoroughbred

(INCLUDES UP TO \$84,000 ITDF) FOR TWO YEAR OLDS REGISTERED INDIANA BRED, COLTS AND GELDINGS PREFERRED.

By subscription of \$50 each, which shall accompany the nomination, \$200 to pass the entry box and an additional \$100 to start, with \$84,000 added. After paying 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth place to last, purse to be divided; 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstakes allowed 3 lbs; non-winners of two races other than maiden or claiming allowed 5 lbs; non-winners of a race other than maiden or claiming allowed 7 lbs; maidens 9 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. This stake will be limited to twelve starters. If more than twelve horses pass the entry box preference will be (1) Colts and Geldings (2) High Weights (3) Highest 2010 earnings will be used in determining order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. Entry fee only will be refunded if failure to draw into race. Two horses having common ties through ownership cannot start to the exclusion of a single interest. (S)

BELLAMY JONES set the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn then drew off in the stretch under a steady drive. NORTHERN SWEEPER was bumped at the start and trailed the field early, angled into the four path in the turn then moved up in the stretch while no match for the winner. DAMION E. T. broke in at the start, angled into the three path in the turn and improved position late in the stretch run. ELLENBERGER PARK was unhurried early, angled into the five path in the turn with no late bid in the stretch. HALFMINEHALFYOURS was well placed early, angled off the rail into the turn and faded late. PICO SUAVE tracked the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and was empty in the stretch. STORM OF ATLANTIS was squeezed shortly after leaving the gate, swung into the six path in the turn and veered in during the stretch drive. WHAT ABOUT RUBY stalked the pace early, angled into the five path in the turn and soon retreated. RUMORS EVERYWHERE was bumped early then was rushed up and eventually spent. AFTER A STEWARDS INQUIRY, DAMION E.T. WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED LAST FOR INTERFERENCE AT THE START.
