SLIM SHADY'S LADY set the pace while racing off the rail, was well handled then drew off in mid stretch and was clearly the best in the end. JUST LIKE JULIET was unhurried early then rallied five wide in the stretch, was gaining ground and was up for the place in the end. IN THE WAGON chased the early pace while racing two wide into the turn, made a bid in upper stretch but came up empty in the end. PLAY SOLEIL chased the pace while inside, made a bid coming out of the turn to mid stretch then flattened out in the drive. IRISH EXCHANGE raced three wide on the turn and was no factor. TAKE INTEREST chased the early pace while racing three wide into the turn, was used up and stopped in the stretch drive.
