UNREACHABLE STAR well back and on the rail, angled out through the second turn, fanned five wide to bid into the stretch, drifted in and drove clear. UNJUST stalked the early pace three wide, bid on that path into the stretch, dueled, shook clear, then was outfinished. NEED MONEY DAD mid pack and outside, gained contention through the second turn, bid three wide into the stretch, was pushed in by a drifted rival, altered out for clear racing room, then could no threaten. ARE N AIDE well back and three wide, came four wide into the stretch, got up for a share late. MO FASTER close up and outside, drifted to the rail through the stretch, flattened out. ROYALY LUCKEY close up and on the rail, had no rally. LAZ HAS RISEN fractious in the gate, was no factor. ARROSON set the early pace on the rail, hit the rail straightening for home, stopped.
