Footnotes

LENAROSE settled outside to track the pace racing three wide, moved up four wide on the far turn to reach CITY PRAYER leaving the furlong marker, dueled to the wire and gamely prevailed in the closing jump. CITY PRAYER broke outward and bumped soundly with GOLD 'N QUIET, pulled her rider to the front from five wide on the first turn, remained under a strong hold heading up the backstretch to shake off a challenge on the far turn, dueled late and could not hold the winner safe. S TABLE DANCER settled outside heading up the backstretch, moved up outside through the far turn to rally six wide into the stretch and have aim through midstretch but could not produce the needed late effort. DEJA VU DIVA saved ground to the far turn, angled out to rally five wide into the stretch but could not sustain the effort. SPANISH LASS stalked the pace racing three wide, angled in through the far turn to bid along the rail in upper stretch but faltered in the closing furlong. HELLISH angled three wide heading up the backstretch, improved position through the far turn but was not threat in the late going. LITE DUTY JUDY saved ground and was not a factor. ENDEAVOR SKY was always back racing outside. GOLD 'N QUIET was bumped soundly and stumbled at the start to come away slowly, moved up outside to make a strong three wide through the far turn then tired on entering the stretch. The rider of GOLD 'N QUIET lodged a claim of foul against the place horse for alleged interference at the start but the claim was not allowed. AUNT LAURA chased the pace from along the inside to late backstretch and tired.
