COOSA RIVER was settled off the pace, angled five wide into the turn then took over the lead in the stretch and edged clear late under a steady drive. SPURS AND SPIKES was well placed early, angled three wide into the turn and made a bid in the stretch run but hung in the final strides. UNBRIDLED SOLDIER set the pace, angled off the rail into the turn and gave way in the stretch drive. MO'S BLACK GOLD chased the pace, angled off the rail into the turn with no rally in the stretch. OUTLAW JR. was unhurried early, angled three wide into the turn and moved up. B. A. CAT was back early, angled four wide into the turn and improved position. MAGIC BUCK was outrun early and passed tired rivals. FORTWAYNECAT showed brief speed then folded up. MAHARAJI was through after a half. LITTLEBALLOFFIRE was done early.
