MYSTERY GUEST broke inward, stalked from inside, went for the lead along the rail leaving the turn, gained a slight advantage, was all out and held on. MANDU GENIUS progressed from outside, lost ground fanning six wide into the lane, dueled for the lead, lugged in deep stretch and could not get past MYSTERY GUEST. READY'S ROCKET rated toward the outside, commenced his bid on the turn, five wide at the head of the lane, was blocked, altered out to the middle of the track with three-sixteenths left, took over third then also lugged in deep stretch. JOHNNY CADILLAC forced in at the start, was settled just off the inside, swung out behind READY'S ROCKET entering the lane, gradually altered out nearing the final furlong and steadily advance. NEED MONEY DAD forwardly placed between horses from the beginning, closed the gap some on the turn, was just inside MANDU GENIUS into the stretch, tried hard but did not have enough left the last eighth. RED LAKE MINISTER showed first, contested the pace from outside, three and four wide taking the turn then gradually wore down in the stretch. TIME TO PLAY dueled for the lead from inside, floated out some leaving the turn and also weakened for the drive. BULBRUSH also broke inward, contested the pace just outside TIME TO PLAY, faded in the stretch, ducked out under the whip inside the final sixteenth and was taken up. CHOKER SETTER steadied behind traffic in the early going, moved to the outside going to the turn, drifted out entering the bend, in path four into the stretch and had little to offer. DOUGHNUT MAN forced in at the start, ran in midpack between horses, could not keep up leaving the turn, was blocked three wide at the top of the stretch, altered out as JOHNNY CADILLAC did near the eighth pole but was empty.
