Footnotes

TIN CUP CHALICE broke alertly, showed the way in hand from paths two or three, moved clear when asked leaving the second bend, was all out deep stretch and held on. PYRO angled in going to the first bend, progressed between horses, was blocked on the backstretch and second turn, squeezed through five wide upper stretch, drifted out with a furlong left, was corrected, closed and caught ACAI for second. ACAI forced in at the start, was soon prominent five wide, squeezed through between rivals on the second turn to vie for the lead, in path four at the head of the lane, tried hard, could not close the gap the last eighth but was clearly best of the rest. I. M. BOOMER caught in tight quarters after the break, jostled wit CHOW WAGON briefly, was rated toward the outside, also made his move in close quarters on the second turn, five wide at the top of the stretch, forced out some nearing the three-sixteenths pole then again nearing the furlong marker, angled inside PYRO shortly after and finished evenly. POWER GAME well placed inside throughout, lacked the needed stretch bid. HE'S EZE also rated between horses the first half, picked up his pace and angled in entering the second turn, was blocked and altered out midway on that bend, lost ground eight wide into the stretch, found best stride inside the final furlong but also lugged in through the waning yards. BUDGE MAN was checked when cut off into the first bend, taken outside, settled, made his move seven wide on the second turn but could not sustain his bid through the lane. CHRIS GOT EVEN bumped after the start, pressed from between horses, two wide taking the second turn then

flattened for the drive. FAMOUS PATRIOT forwardly placed between horses, went for the lead five wide on the second turn but faded in the lane. CUBFANBUDMAN failed to menace in a ground-saving trip. CHOW WAGON jostled with I. M. BOOMER then CHRIS GOT EVEN after the start, was never far off the inside and showed little. ASMODEUS displayed early speed just outside TIM CUP CHALICE, began to back up in tight quarters three wide into the second bend, was steadied and quit.
