TAKE IT LIKE A MAN pressed the pace while racing two wide, made a bid going to the top of the stretch then came up empty in late stretch. DEADLY TRUTH raced two wide on the turn and failed to menace in the stretch drive. VINEGAR HILL was inside on the turn then made a bid, bore out at the top of the stretch then flattened out in the drive. SID'S SONG raced three wide on the turn and was no factor. WHISKEY RUNNER raced four wide on the turn and was no threat in the stretch drive.
