AN ALLOWANCE STAKE FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$100 each which shall accompany the nomination, \$400 to pass the entry box and \$500 additional to start. Weight 124 lbs. Fillies, 121 lbs. Non-winners of \$50,000 at a mile over in 2002 allowed 3 lbs; of \$30,000 at any distance in 2002, 5 lbs; three races other than maiden or claiming 7 lbs; two such races 9 lbs. High weights preferred. If more than twelve horses pass the entry box, preference will be (1) High weights (2) Highest 2002 earnings. Entry fee only will be refunded if failure to draw into race. Supplementary nominations of \$7,500 each by the time of closing Wednesday, October 2, 2002. Closed Saturday, September 21, 2002 with 40 nominations.



Footnotes

PERFECT DRIFT tucked in behind the early pace while in good striking position, angled three wide to make his bid through the far turn and show in front turning for home, edged clear then was under a strong drive to hold EASYFROMTHEGITGO safe to the end. EASYFROMTHEGITGO bobbled at the start, was allowed to settle along the inside to save ground, launched his rally through the far turn while remaining inside, closed on the winner while angling out through midstretch and finished willingly but came up short. PREMEDITATION stalked the pace out from the rail, angled out through the far turn to rally four to five wide into the stretch and closed willingly to midstretch but could not reach the top pair in the late going. M B SEA angled in going to the first turn to save ground, continued to move up along the inside through the far turn into the lane, angled out through midstretch and closed willingly but was too late. SPEED HUNTER settled along the inside in good striking position throughout but could not muster a solid closing response. PASS RUSH was close up to the pace racing three to four wide, remained prominent through upper stretch then lugged in nearing the eighth marker and weakened. JOEY FRANCO settled outside off the early pace, fanned six wide into the stretch then lugged in soon after turning for home and lacked a closing response. FIGHTING INDIANS raced in reach of the pace while three to four wide and tired in the lane. WISEMAN'S FERRY dueled on the pace inside CITY SHARPSTER through solid fractions, resisted the winner through upper stretch but tired and drifted out in the late going. CITY SHARPSTER dueled outside WISEMAN'S FERRY and dropped back through the far turn while tiring. ROBIN ZEE was fractious in the starting gate and was always back. PRIVATE HORDE was

never a factor racing outside.
