Footnotes

HARMONIZER never far back and inside, gained a striking position through the second turn, came through inside of rivals into the stretch, altered out for clear racing room, then drew off the final furlong under steady pressure. BULLNOSE BRICK void of speed, moved up through the second turn on the two path, came three wide to bid into the stretch, then made a steady gain to get up for the place while no threat to the winner. BOBBY SANDS well placed and between rivals, angled out to bid three wide into the stretch, then lacked the needed late kick. DONTLAFFHESPAIDFOR set the early pace inside pulling, regained the lead through the second turn, then faded the final furlong. HURLING was no factor, inside. OK NOTHANKSFORASKN vied for the early lead outside, gained a short lead in the backstretch and faltered.
