Footnotes

PACIFIC DANGER set the pace early, while on the inside into the far turn then drifted in while in the stretch and drew clear in the final stages under a steady drive. DOIN BIG BIDNESS stalked the pace early from the inside, stayed on the rail into the far turn then made a bid in the stretch but flattened out late in the drive. SORGHO tracked the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn then made a bid in the stretch but hung late. MOUNT DOLLBERG raced up close early, then steadied going into the far turn, angled into the four path inside the quarter pole and weakened late in the stretch. BLUE SOLITUDE angled off the rail into the far turn and was empty late in the stretch run. R FAST CAT chased the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn and faded late in the stretch. ACHIEVABLE was through after a half.
