Footnotes

FATHER JOHN rated on the front end from inside, opened up when asked and proved much the best under steady handling. LAZ HAS RISEN pressed from outside, four wide into the lane, took over second, began to weaken late and narrowly held the place. LIEPERS FORK in midpack from outside, forced to go five wide for room into the lane, lacked the needed late bid but moved clear for third in the waning yards. MOKEN settled inside, bid entering the stretch, battled for third but did not have enough left late. UNREACHABLE STAR was without early foot, fanned out six wide into the lane, progressed to midstretch then finished evenly. LOVE THIS TRICK dueled for the lead between rivals, three wide leaving the second turn, could not stay with FATHER JOHN in the stretch, steadied briefly as he began to fade in close quarters and continued to flatten. BEST PROSPECT steadily faded between horses, saved ground on the second turn and had little left for the drive. CLASSIC ORDER failed to menace in a ground-saving trip. SEATTLE BY THE SEA was checked repeatedly while boxed in behind the early speed, had a clear path four wide on the second turn but came up empty through the stretch. FLAT OUT RICH stayed off the inside and showed little.
