ELLENBERGER PARK tracked the early pace inside, gained a striking position through the second turn, came through inside of rivals into the stretch, then made a steady gain and edged ahead in the final strides. FRANKLIN'S BRIAR well placed and outside, moved up three wide through the second turn, came four wide to bid into the stretch, gained a short lead the final furlong and was outfinished. BETONAWINNER well back and inside, moved up three wide through the second turn, bid four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. HEZA WINNER TOO well back and outside, angled in to move up through the second turn, altered out in the stretch for clear racing room and passed tiring rivals for a share. MUCHACHO ALEGRE had a wide trip and improved his position. J. C. DOMINGUEZ stalked the early pace from between rivals while pulling, gained a short lead into the second turn and faded in the drive. RODS RUNNING REDD well placed and three wide, bid on that path and had no stretch rally. DERBY CODE set the early pace inside and was through after a half.
