STAKES Indiana Oaks Grade 2 - Thoroughbred

(PLUS UP TO 40% ITDF) FOR THREE YEAR OLD FILLIES. By subscription of \$100 each which shall accompany the nomination \$200 to pass the entry box and \$200 additional to start, with \$200,000 added. Supplementary nominations may be made by the usual time of closing of entries for a fee \$1,000 which includes entry and starting fees. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last the purse will be divided; 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth.

Weight: 121 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 once or \$30,000 twice at a mile or over in 2012, allowed 2 lbs; of \$30,000 at a mile or over in 2012, 4 lbs; of three races other than maiden or claiming, 6 lbs. This stake will be limited to twelve starters. If more than twelve horses pass the entry box, preference will be given to (1) Grade/Group 1 winners, (2) Grade/Group 2 winners and Grade/Group 1 place finishers, (3) Grade/Group 3 winners and Grade/Group 2 place finishers, (4) Highest Lifetime Earnings. The entry fee will be refunded if a horse fails to draw into the race.

GRACE HALL was well placed while racing two wide on the backstretch, moved up while in hand and took command on the far turn, was asked for a run coming out of the far turn and quickly drew away, was tapped once in mid stretch then was ridden out in the end. WINE PRINCESS stalked the pace while racing on the inside down the backstretch, rallied and moved out to be four wide in upper stretch then was in a hard drive to be along for the place but was no match for the winner in the end. EDEN'S MOON set a pressured pace from the inside, was well handled then was asked for a response when challenged at the top of the stretch then weakened in the stretch drive. HOLIDAY SOIREE stalked the pace while racing three wide on the backstretch, made a bid on the far turn then faltered in the drive. UPTOWN BERTIE was unhurried early while racing two wide on the backstretch, was used up then gave way in the stretch.
