STAKES Indiana Derby Grade 2 - Thoroughbred

(PLUS UP TO 40% ITDF) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$100 each which shall accompany the nomination, \$400 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start with \$500,000 added. Supplementary nominations may be made by the usual time of closing of entries for a fee \$2,000 which includes entry and starting fees. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last the remainder of the purse will be divided; 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights: Three Year Olds, 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 once or \$30,000 twice at a mile or over in 2012, allowed 3 lbs; of \$30,000 at a mile or over in 2012, 5 lbs; of three races other than maiden or claiming, 7 lbs. Maiden, claiming, starter and state bred races will not be considered when estimating allowances.

Footnotes

NECK 'N NECK was unhurried early while racing seven wide on the backstretch, rallied five wide into the far turn then swung out to be seven wide in upper stretch, had clear running room and was in a strong drive and powered to the front in late stretch to prove best. BOURBON COURAGE was four wide on the first turn then was shuffled back on the backstretch, rallied four wide on the far turn then swung out to be six wide in upper stretch and behind the winner, closed ground willingly to be up for the place. FED BIZ dueled for the early lead while two wide, was in a long drive then gamely dug in throughout the stretch drive but was outfinished in late stretch for the place. MORGAN'S GUERRILLA stalked the pace while inside, made a bid on the far turn and stayed inside for the stretch drive but came up empty in the end. AFFORD was unhurried early on then rallied heading into the far turn making a bold move five wide, stayed with the leaders throughout the stretch drive but flattened out in late stretch. TRITAP stalked the pace while racing three wide then made a strong three wide bid on the far turn to mid stretch, was in tight quarters in mid stretch and weakened in the end. O'PRADO AGAIN was allowed to settled

while racing two wide, was shuffled back entering the far turn then swung out to be six wide in upper stretch but was no menace in the drive. EASTER GIFT was unhurried early then rallied five wide on the far turn but failed to menace in the stretch. JUNEBUGRED was hustled along from the gate and dueled for the lead while inside, was in a long drive throughout but weakened in late stretch. SECOND CITY was four wide on the backstretch while being pulled along to the front, was used up and gave way in the stretch drive. STEALCASE was allowed to settled then raced three wide on backstretch and far turn, swung out to be eight wide in upper stretch but was no threat in the stretch drive.
