STAKES Hoosier Breeders Sophomore S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

(INCLUDES UP TO \$42,000 ITDF) FOR REGISTERED INDIANA BRED THREE YEAR OLD FILLIES. By subscription of \$50 each which shall accompany the nomination, \$200 to pass the entry box, and an additional \$100 to start, with \$84,000 added.

Supplementary nominations may be made by the usual time of closing of entries for a fee \$840 which includes entry and starting fees. After paying 1% to owners of horses finishing sixth through last, the remaining purse will be divided; 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weight: 124 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstakes allowed 3 lbs; of two races other than maiden or claiming, 5 lbs; of a race other than maiden or claiming, 7 lbs; maidens, 9 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to twelve starters. If more than twelve horses pass the entry box preference will be given to high weights, highest lifetime earnings will then determine the preference of horses assigned equal weights. The entry fee will be refunded if a horse fails to draw into the race. (S)

YEARLEY stalked the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn then took over command in the stretch and drew off late under a steady drive. SAINT D'AROK tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn then altered course in the stretch to the inside and was no match for the winner. GLOSSED AND FOUND was unhurried early, angled into the five path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch drive. ANGELS TRACE chased the pace early then steadied into the far turn, angled into the three path inside the quarter pole and faded late in the stretch. DETERMINED YANKEE set the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn and was tired in the stretch while drifting out. CORYDONMARIA was well placed early, angled into the four path in the far turn and was empty in the stretch run. RED LITE NITE was done early. SQUARE TOE BOOTS trailed the field throughout.
