SWEET LAUR, allowed to settle well off her rivals in the opening stages, angled to the outside entering the backstretch to make a steady gain five wide into the far turn, circled foes on the far bend to collar the pacesetter, edged forward of that rival in mid stretch and held her safe under firm handling. PRETTY LILLY quickly showed in front, angled inwards a bit while setting the pace under light rating, resisted the winner when challenged but came up second best approaching the wire. TRICKY DETAILS tracked the pace on the outside in second flight, closed the gap on the far turn, but couldn't produce a closing response. TRIPLE BEAU stalked the pace along the inside into the backstretch, switched out to challenge leaving the far turn, raced five wide in the stretch but couldn't make any further impact. MONA LISALOU dwelt at the start, lost position in the opening stages and never gained striking position. TIME FOR GRACE tracked the pace between foes into the backstretch, couldn't sustain any further effort racing through the far turn and gave way. JUSTBACKWARDGLANCE chased the leaders from the break, bore out racing into the first turn and never threatened thereafter. MISS DUSTY was urged to secure position along the rail while chasing the pacesetter into the backstretch, quickly emptied out after a half and stopped.
