SLEWEY ARMSTRONG was unhurried into the turn while in the two or three path, moved closer to the inside entering the lane, split rivals inside the eighth pole and edged to the front inside the sixteenth pole under left handed urging. PLENILUNIO saved ground into the lane, angled out into the four path in the lane, gained a led inside the eighth pole then could not hold off the winner. MOUNT TORA BORA trailed for three quarters while off the rail, fanned widest into the lane and finished with good energy. MOMENT OF SONG forced the pace while two wide into the lane, gained a narrow advantage with an eighth to go then weakened. HONOR MY GRADES raced in the three path into the lane, bid after straightening then hung in the critical stages. AL JOHNSTAN was never a serious threat while being brushed by another rival near the eighth pole. MOE B DICK set the pace under pressure into the turn then tired through the lane. ENDER'S SHADOW tracked the leaders into the turn then had nothing in the lane.
