STAKES Indiana Derby Grade 2 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$100 each which shall accompany the nomination, \$400 to pass the entry box and \$500 additional to start. With \$500,000 added, after payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight:124 lbs. Fillies:121 lbs. Non-winners of \$50,000 at one mile or over in 2006, 3 lbs.; of \$30,000 at any distance in 2006, 5 lbs.; three races other than maiden or claiming, 7 lbs.; two such races, 9 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing (72 Hour Closing). Trophy to the winning owner. High weights preferred. NOTE: This stake will be limited to twelve starters. If more than twelve horses pass the entry box, preference will be (1) High weights; (2) Highest Lifetime Earnings. Two horses having common ties through ownership cannot start to the exclusion of a single interest. Entry fee only will be refunded if failure to draw into the race.

Footnotes

STAR DABBLER set the pace down the backstretch while just off the rail, remained clear into the lane, was caught near the sixteenth pole, lost the lead then dug in late to finish on even terms. CIELO GOLD was put in tight early and dropped well back down the backstretch, gained momentum through the turn while saving ground, angled to mid-track for the drive, caught the leader inside the eighth pole, gained a short advantage inside the sixteenth pole then was

all out to the wire. SMOKEYJONESSUTTON was unhurried early while off the rail, moved four wide through the turn when gaining momentum, fanned into mid-track for the drive and gained the minor share while not a threat to the top two. MANTOLOKING raced close up down the backstretch while near the rail, bid from between rivals entering the far turn, remained in contention with an eighth to go then weakened. PLUG ME IN was well placed into the turn, bid while four wide through the turn then weakened. SIMON PURE tracked the pacesetters while near the inside then tired. BRIGHT ONE was brushed early but quickly gained position, was brushed and forced out while moving three wide into the first turn, remained well out from the rail while pursuing the pacesetters, moved five wide into the turn and remained far out from the rail throughout the turn then was empty upon entering the lane. ACTS LIKE A KING stalked the pace three wide into the turn then tired. JACINTH was shut off early when rival came over then was never a contender while in the four path. SUMMER GULCH was bumped from both sides early, dropped back and trailed.
