COMMEMORATE BRUCE stalked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn then took over command in the stretch and drew away late under a brisk drive. BOOTLEG was well placed early, angled into the three path in the turn with some late gain in the stretch and was up for place. SILVER SPUR was unhurried early, angled into the three path in the turn with a mild gain in the stretch run. FLYLIKABIRD pressed the pace early from the inside, stayed on the rail into the turn and weakened late in the stretch. SIR JIM never menaced. WINTER FROST was on the inside into the turn while no threat. SIAGON TRAFFIC COP tracked the pace early, while on the inside into the turn and faded late in the stretch drive. SHORT SALE was done early. RAPID WARRIOR set the pace for a half then folded up.
