MOONSHINE STILL close up and three wide, angled in into the turn, bid three wide into the stretch, dueled with DUCKY'S ICE CREAM in upper stretch, got clear, driving. DUCKY'S ICE CREAM stalked the pace outside, angled in into the turn, dueled with the winner late, missed. ZYGLOW second flight and four wide in the early going, angled in to bid into the turn, came to the pace setter into the stretch, close well but lacked the late response needed. LORI'S LITTLETRICK void of speed, gained position through the turn, altered out in the stretch for clear racing room then made a steady gain, while no threat. LOVE THIS TRICK passed tiring rivals. OAK RICH second flight and between rivals showed little. CHIS MAGIC second flight and on the rail, dropped back through the turn, faded there after. HAARMAN set the early pace on the rail, faded. GOBAIN had a rail trip and was no factor. MO GUSTO pulled up in the stretch, bled.
