Footnotes

BULLNOSE BRICK stalked the pace outside, took command through the turn, gained a clear lead in mid stretch and was kept to the task. SKIPP N HOPP close up and three wide, bid on that path into the stretch, made a steady gain to be clearly second best while no threat to the winner. BILLE AND BUZZY second flight and five wide, angled in slightly into the turn, bid on the four path into the stretch, drifted in under left hand urging and got up for the show late. LAKE LEELANAU rushed up to set the early pace on the rail, could not go with the winner into the stretch but kept position and tired in the late going. SPECIAL BILL close up and three wide in the early going, was pinched back into the turn, gained position again into the stretch and had a mild gain. FIRE AT WILL never far back and outside, angled in through the turn, bid into the stretch and lacked the late response needed. COOL TRICK showed little. RESTLESS CITY close up and on the rail, dropped back through the turn, then had no stretch rally. GIMME A BUD trailed the field.
