JIMMY GOT EVEN was unhurried early, angled into the five path in the turn then rallied in the stretch and drove past the leader in the final stages. DOC GARRITY pressed the pace early while three wide, angled off the rail into the turn, made a bid in the stretch but hung late. TOO MUCH WINE set the pace early from the inside, stayed on the rail into the turn and yielded late in the stretch run. UNDER LIKE THUNDER chased the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and weakened late. LORD KYLE'S QUEST was well placed early, angled into the five path in the turn and lacked a late bid in the stretch. PALLASO tracked the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn and faded late. R GOLDEN MOMENT was never a threat. WISHING SKY broke awkwardly from the gate and was no factor. INDISCREET AFFAIR was through after a half. PARAMOUNT GAMBOL was always outrun.
