STAGE MAGIC set the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn, remained clear in the stretch and held sway in the final stages. SILKEN MIST was unhurried early, while on the inside into the far turn then made a bid in the stretch but did not have enough late. PRINCES EVEN chased the pace early, while on the inside into the far turn, made a bid in the stretch but hung late. PEARL OF VALOR bobbled at the start then stalked the pace early, angled into the four path in the far turn and weakened late in the stretch. DERBY LANE'S SONG angled into the four path in the far turn while no threat. ROSSINI'S MUSE raced up close early, angled off the rail into the far turn and faded late. GERWINII tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn and was empty in the stretch run. DR. POWERS was done early.
