C J'S BRAHMS was unhurried early then rallied heading into the far turn, moved out to be six wide in the middle of the far turn, was in a strong drive in the stretch and power3ed to the front in late stretch. LILLEANDRA stalked the pace while racing thee wide on the backstretch, rallied on the far turn making a strong bid, gained a slim lead in upper stretch but came up empty in late stretch. MISS INDY CINDY was allowed to settle while racing on the inside, made a bid three wide on the far turn then was in a hard drive but weakened in late stretch. EASTER DELL set a pressured pace from the inside, drew off on the far turn then weakened in the stretch drive. HUNTING HONEY was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn five wide, angled inside in mid stretch but was no menace. DOWN ON COPPERLINE was allowed to settle while inside in the early going, made a bid then moved out to be four wide on the far turn to mid stretch then flattened out in late stretch. PINK KITTEN pressed the pace while two wide on the backstretch, was hard used then gave way on the far turn. ANA KENA chased the pace while racing three wide on the backstretch, was used up then faltered in the stretch drive.
