Footnotes

EXTREME CAUTION broke alertly, gradually angled in as he set the pace, saved ground through the turn then held off SPURTABILITY under steady urging. SPURTABILITY pressed EXTREME CAUTION from outside, two wide into the lane and could only make up minor ground late. NOBLE AMBASSADOR forwardly placed inside, was steadied behind EXTREME CAUTION near the half mile pole, angled out three wide for room into the stretch and found best stride too late. BEST REFLECTION rated inside, was steadied when JIM'S RUSTY GEM took his path into the turn, just off the rail leaving the bend, made a strong move in the stretch, was blocked in the waning yards and altered in. JIM'S RUSTY GEM settled between horses, moved to the rail into the turn, picked up his pace, altered out four wide upper stretch for a clear path and closed well. A. J. GROOM stumbled at the start, was soon at the back, stayed well off the inside throughout, lodged a mild bid into the stretch and passed tired ones. BARBARA'S PRINCE in contention between horses, was three to five wide through the bend then made up ground the last eighth without improving his position. KAI U BUMPED at the start, was steadied, was widest through the turn and lacked a serious stretch bid. SINGLE G broke inward, bumping KAI U, displayed early speed between horses but gave way three wide at the top of the lane.
