IRON GIRL stalked the pace early from the three path, angled into the five path in the turn then edged clear in the stretch under a steady drive. DELTA CHARM chased the pace early, swung into the six path in the turn and got up for place late. VICTORY PUNCH was bumped at the start then pressed the early pace, angled into the four path in the turn and faltered late. BLACK EYED SUSIE was bumped at the start, angled into the three path in the turn with a mild gain in the stretch. FUELEDBYMOONSHINE was bumped at the start then set the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn and gave way in the stretch. DURABLE angled into the four path in the turn while no threat. LA ESCONDIDA swung into the six path in the turn while no factor. GINNYPOO showed brief speed then retreated.
