STAKES TRIAL Governor's Stakes Trial - Quarter Horse

FOR REGISTERED QUARTER HORSES, TWO YEARS OLD. Weight: 122 lbs. By subscription of \$200 to nominate to the trials, with an additional \$300 to start in the trials. All nomination and starting fees to be added to the final purse of the Governors Stake. The top ten fastest qualifiers will remain eligible to enter the Governors Stake. As many trials will be run as deemed necessary. Each field will be limited to ten starters. If less than (14) fourteen horses nominate to the trials by the time of closing, the trials will be cancelled. Of the horses nominated to the trials, the (10) ten horses with the highest 2010 earnings at the time of nominating will remain eligible to run in the finals. All nomination fees will be refunded to horses not selected for the stake, should trials not be run. Assistant starters will be supplied to all competitors. A negative coggins and health certificate issued within the past 30 days for out of state horses and proof of herpes vaccination within the past six months must accompany each horse. Final Purse for the Governors Stake \$75,000 added.
