RON THE GREEK slow early, taken back and trailed the field to the quarter pole, angled into the five path in the turn, circled the field and launched a furious rush to finish fast and run down his entry mate at the wire in impressive fashion. GRINDER set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn, drew clear in the stretch with what looked like an insurmountable lead but was caught at the wire. FIVE STAR PRINCE tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn and weakened late in the stretch run. FROSTED RHYTHM chased the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn with no late bid in the stretch drive. LEGIONARY was well placed early, angled into the four path in the turn and faded late in the stretch. KENTUCKY THUNDER angled off the rail into the turn and steadily faded. MOUNTAIN TRAIL angled into the five path in the turn while no threat. DABOSSMAN broke awkward from the gate and was no factor. REALLY STORMY was through after a half. ALASKAN TWEFOR TWO was done early.
