NORMA'S DREAM vied for the lead while inside on the run down he backstretch, drew off in upper stretch then was in a long drive and held safe in the end. BELL OF BUDDHA was inside and steadied off heels on the first turn then was settled on the run down the backstretch, made a bid on the far turn and was gaining ground but was second best in the end. BORED TO DEATH was unhurried early then raced three wide on the backstretch, was three wide on the far turn then moved out to be four wide for the stretch drive but was no menace in late stretch. VALARI vied for the early lead while between rivals, was taken back off the pace in the middle of the backstretch and failed to respond in the stretch when asked. GOODWOOD GAL vied for the lead while three wide on the backstretch, was in a long drive then gave way in the stretch drive. MY HONEY stumbled at the start then was allowed to settle and lacked a response in the stretch. ON THE WAY was unhurried early then raced three wide on the far turn but was no threat. MAYBELLE SLEW was unhurried early then raced three wide on the far turn and was no factor. PRETTY GAL TOO stalked the early pace while racing three wide on the backstretch, was used up then faltered in the stretch drive.
