MAGGIE'S DREAM showed sharp speed from the start to open a clear advantage through the turn, continued on well then was under mild intermittent lefthanded urging through the lane to hold a safe margin. SENORITA ZIGGY settled three wide to track the pace and made a mild late gain while edging clear for the place. WINNING GLORY tracked the pace along the inside, angled out turning for home to be nearest the winner but could not produce the needed late effort. MARCIANN broke into the side of the gate to come away slowly then rallied along the inside in an improved effort. THESULLIVANFIVE stalked the pace outside and failed to offer a closing bid. FRIENDLY SPIRIT stumbled at the start and failed to threaten. CINDERDELA angled to the inside going to the turn but lacked a rally. MY PRECIOUS was always back. DIAMOND PLATE showed brief speed outside the winner but dropped back steadily after the opening quarter.
