CAT'S EYE WITNESS tracked the pace racing three to four wide to bid outside JUDY B into the lane, moved clear under a hand ride then was lightly roused inside the sixteenth marker while moving off. PLUM LAWLESS bobbled at the start but quickly recovered to move up three wide and press the pace outside JUDY B, continued on willingly to midstretch and could not match strides while clearly second best. JUDY B moved clear in the opening quarter from along the inside then came up empty in the lane. CLEARLY BEST saved ground and moved up through the lane while not a threat. JE SUIS PREST angled five wide into the lane to move up to midstretch but lacked a late response. A CHANCE TO PASS was close up to the pace while two and three wide then weakened in the lane. HELLO GEORGIE broke outward to bump with a rival, stalked the pace from three wide, angled in turning for home and weakened. BARBATINA was close up to the pace while three and four wide on the turn and weakened. READY OK tired from along the inside. SUNDAY BLESSING was bumped at the start and trailed throughout.
