NEED MONEY DAD stalked the pace outside, bid at the quarter pole, dueled to mid stretch with the early pace setter, drew off, driving. TEE'S BEST MAN chased the pace on the rail, drifted out in the stretch, then back in, could not threaten the winner but was clearly second best. SMARTY SMITH set the pace off the rail, dueled into the stretch, gave way the last sixteenth. UP IN THE BRIDLE tracked the pace in the early going, angled to the rail through the turn, gained a striking position, then had no late response while on the wrong lead. CLASSIC ORDER improved his position. HUSTLIN JOE mid pack and off the rail, lost ground through the stretch run. BOOT SCOOTIN BABY well back in the early going, checked at the half mild pole, then showed little thereafter. BONAFIDE ROCK was never involved. LIVING BREAD was no factor. MO GUSTO bled.
