Footnotes

TENMOR well back and inside in the early going, gained contention through the turn, bid three wide into the stretch to make a steady gain and get up in the final strides. R. P. INDY stumbled at the start, quickly righted himself to track the pace off the rail, fanned four wide to bid into the stretch, gained a clear lead in mid stretch, missed. GEORDIE stalked the pace outside, headed the leader into the stretch, dueled with R.P. INDY through the lane, could not stay with that one but held the show safe. M'NAUGHTEN second flight between foes, angled in into the turn, bid into the stretch to gain a piece. VERY CLEAR well back in the early going, bid five wide into the stretch, then had a mild gain in the lane. BRENT'S BAD BOY set the early pace on the rail, drifted out into the stretch, weakened in the drive. HARVESTIME broke a step slowly and was void of speed, came wide around a breaking down rival into the stretch and could only gain slight position. HOOSIER KINGDOM had a rail trip and showed little. SURPRIZER broke down, vanned off.
