Footnotes

GET ON MY LEVEL vied for the early lead inside, angled out in the backstretch and moved up to head the pace setter, dueled with that one to the final sixteenth and drove clear. WAVE LAND MABEE well back and off the rail, moved up through the second turn, came widest into the stretch and closed well through the lane to get up for the place while no threat to the winner. EXPLODEN MOONSHINE well placed and off the rail, moved up into the second turn, bid three wide into the stretch and ran evenly the final furlong. GOOD BET mid pack and outside, moved up on the two path through the second turn, bid three wide into the stretch and weakened the final furlong. LINDA'S MOONSHINE mid pack and inside, angled out to bid four wide, then drifted in and had a mild gain. OFF BALANCE set the early pace inside and faded the final furlong. THAT'S THE ANSWER well back inside, lugged in through the lane and could not gain. WEEKEND BEAUTY was never involved. RIELLE tracked the early pace inside, angled out through the second turn, lost contact with the field and was eased over the wire.
