**Footnotes**

HARTMANS KOMET was well placed while racing two wide into the turn, rallied on the turn then gained command in upper stretch, drew off in mid stretch then was in a hard drive in late stretch to hold sway. DA SUGA MAN was unhurried early while racing two wide on the turn, rallied then swung out to be four wide for the stretch drive, closed with a rush in late stretch but was too late. BECKNERVILLE chased the pace while racing three wide into the turn, rallied in upper stretch making a bid but hung in late stretch. HEBE'S PRIDE raced three wide on the turn then made a bid in upper stretch but came up empty in the drive. TWO STASH was unhurried early then raced two wide on the turn, swung out to be five wide in upper stretch and made a late gain but was no menace. CAPTAIN STYLES raced two wide into the turn then made a bid but was no menace in the stretch drive. MILITARY ACTION raced four wide on the backstretch and turn then failed to menace in the stretch drive. THE BOY FROM ROY set the early pace, was used up and gave way in the stretch. HOOSIER BUD was through early and stopped. EVANS THUNDER was through after a half and stopped in the stretch drive.
