MAGIC HOUR set a well handled paced from the start, drew off in upper stretch then was in a strong drive and was clearly best in the end. DIVINE HOPE stalked the pace while racing on the inside, saved ground on the far turn then made a bid but was no threat to the winner while being second best. RED BEAN ICE CREAM chased the early pace while racing two wide, made a bid on the far turn but came up empty in the drive. MARTINIS AT LUNCH raced three wide on the backstretch, made a bid on the far turn then failed to menace in the stretch. SILVER PROSPECTS raced on the inside while being unhurried early then failed to menace. REVEAL stalked the pace while racing two wide on the backstretch, was used up and faltered in the stretch. SANTA STREGA raced three wide on the backstretch then was no menace in the stretch. FRANNIE G raced four wide on the turn and was no factor.
