### Footnotes

LAVA FIRE tracked the pace early, while on the inside into the far turn then drew clear in the stretch from the rail under a steady drive. CART'S CRUSIN was unhurried early, angled into the five path in the far turn then rallied in the stretch but did not have enough late. JUSTICE SCORES set the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn and faltered late in the stretch run. GO SPANISH CODE stalked the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn and weakened late. MI VIERA angled into the four path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch. AMAZON WALL chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the far turn and faded late. BURNING SECRET was done early. JOURNEY TO THE TOP was through after a half. PABST ANNIE showed little. SUGAR BUCK had early speed then retreated.
