BELLA'S FELLA vied for the early lead outside, took command through the turn, then drew off in the lane and was kept to the task. POPS IS TOPS void of speed, came through inside of rivals into the stretch, altered out for clear racing room and closed willingly to get up for the place while no threat to the winner. SCATTERFIELD well back and outside, angled in and moved up through the turn, closed well through the lane and passed tiring rivals to gain the show. PRINCE LARRY set the early pace well off the rail, could not go with the winner through the turn, stayed on to hold a share. COMING ON well placed and four wide, dropped back slightly through the turn, bid on the same path into the stretch and ran evenly in the lane. BUSTER ROSE mid pack and inside, gained a striking position on the two path through the turn, bid three wide into the stretch and faded the final furlong. INDY BULL tracked the pace on the rail and was through after a half. PORT ROYAL TEE appeared hard to rate, was erratic through the turn and was outrun.
