GHOST CHAPEL sprinted to a clear quickly under a hold, shook off a challenge through the second turn, drew off in the stretch and was kept to the task. HE'S DANGEROUS wel placed and off the rail, angled out in the stretch for clear racing room and closed willingly to get up for the place while no threat to the winner. DONT TELL KITTEN void of speed and inside, moved up through the second turn, fanned widest for the drive and closed willingly through the lane to get up for the show. MEADOW WISE stalked the pace outside, moved up to bid through the second turn, then weakened in the drive. I. M. BOOMER showed little, inside. ALL IN SLEW was no factor, outside.
