SMOKY BELLE set the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn then drew off in the stretch under a steady drive. WILD ABOUT MARIE was well placed early, angled into the three path in the turn while no match for the winner in the stretch run. BIG LOU pressed the pace early from between horses, while on the inside into the turn and weakened late in the stretch. MIN D'ORO trailed the field early, angled off the rail into the turn and moved up in the stretch drive. PICK AND PRAY angled into the four path in the turn and improved position. BARTON SPRINGS was on the inside into the turn and faded late. WICKED UNO vied early for the lead while three wide, angled off the rail into the turn and was empty in the stretch. OH WHATA HOLIDAY was done early. DANCE WITH CLASS was through after a half.
