ADIOS DWIGHT well placed and three wide, gained position through the turn, came four wide to bid into the stretch, edged ahead at the eighth pole, then drew off late under steady handling. I SEE A SHARK bobbed at the start, was mid pack and outside, angled in into the turn and rallied up in the final strides for the place. MORO'S ADVENTURER set the early pace inside, could not go with the winner at the eighth pole, stayed on and weakened late. LAST STAMP vied for the early lead outside and faded the final furlong. H K JUNIOR mid pack and outside, gained position through the turn, came widest into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. CHECK THIS ORDER improved his position. LASTING POWER pinched back at the start, was erratic. HEZA WINNER TOO showed little. TIME FOR FUN was a brief factor.
