Footnotes

WIN DOUGH REID stalked the early pace outside, moved up to challenge through the second turn, gained a clear lead in the stretch, then drew off while being kept to the task. LOST SECRET tracked the early pace on the rail, came through inside of rivals into the stretch, angled out for clear racing room, then found room inside and closed well to get up for the place while no threat to the winner. JAYDEE well back and inside, angled out and eased up through the backstretch, came widest into the stretch and closed willingly to get up for the show while no threat to the top two. MANCHESSEE MANCHEDO well placed and off the rail, passed tiring rivals through the lane for a share. THURBEN mid pack and inside, moved up on the two path through the second turn, gained a striking position into the lane and weakened in the drive. SIR RUDY set the early pace off the rail and faded after three quarters. HOOSIER MO showed little. CROWNFORADAY was never involved. STEALNTHISONE mid pack and outside, looped rivals three wide through the second turn, lost his action behind and was pulled up and vanned off.
