Footnotes

UNBRIDLED ONE tracked the early pace inside, dropped back slightly into the turn, angled out into the stretch, split rivals mid stretch, bumped, drifted out and closed fast to get up in time. LORD AVIE JONES set a pressured pace outside, drew clear through the turn, steadied slightly into the stretch, drew off, got caught the final stride. LAWYER DAGGETT came through traffic in the early going to rush up to contention, fanned six wide to bid into the stretch, drifted in, bumped the winner, then was carried out by that one and could not threaten. CLIFF'S BEST BET well back and on the rail, angled out in the stretch for clear racing to get up for a share. TOUGH LITTLE NUT mid pack and outside, gained contention into the stretch to bid four wide, hung. BROTHER WALTER close up and off the rail, remained in striking distance to mid stretch, then could not gain. SGT MAJOR SCHLOSKEY improved his position. SIR JIM was no factor. GLITTER POWER pressed the pace inside, stopped. GRANS FRISCO was eased to the wire.
