Footnotes

EUROEARS set the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn, drew clear in the stretch under a steady drive. CHIEF TALKEETNA stalked the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn with no late gain on winner in the stretch. STOLEN CHEVY was unhurried early, swung into the six path in the turn and moved up in the stretch run. PREMIUM WINE chased the pace early, angled into the five path in the turn and weakened late in the stretch drive. TOP ECHELON was on the inside into the turn and steadily faded. BELEND was through after a half. RARE POWER bobbled at the start and was no factor.
