HUNTINGTON'S BEST sprinted to a clear lead well off the rail, turned back a challenge into the turn, then drew off in the lane while being kept to the task. ROYAL GENT moved up quickly three wide, challenged into the turn, could not go with the winner through the turn, stayed on to be clearly best of the rest. HANDSOME HANKERS well back and inside, moved up on the two path through the turn, bid between rivals into the stretch and got up for the show while no threat to the top two. TEXAS HOLDEM JOE well placed and inside, came through inside of rivals into the stretch, lost ground through the lane while holding a share. BA SKED E OH'S stalked the pace outside, came four wide to bid into the stretch and faded the final furlong. BOLD AND UNBRIDLED passed tiring rivals. HAM I AM tracked the early pace off the rail and was through after a half. WHATA WAKI was a brief factor, outside. HI HO IM SILVER was outrun.
