TRIFECTA MARIA was well placed, rallied, but failed to sustain bid. ARRACADA was unhurried early, had a mild rally, then lacked a late response. WARM WOMAN stalked the pace evenly, with no rally. LET'S BOOK OUT flashed brief speed, gave way, then dropped back. DINNER BY CANDLITE was through after a half, then dropped back. BOB'S ANGEL had brief speed, then stopped.
